PUBLIC NOTICE

Beginning, Monday, November 2, 2020. the Rocky Top Public Library will begin their Phase 2 re-opening process. The following guidelines will be in place until further notice due to community health concerns surrounding the COVID-19 virus.

The total occupancy for the library will be 10 people (including staff). You will be required to have a temperature check.

You MUST wear a mask at all times while inside the library. You must have library business to come inside the building. Backpacks or baggage will not be permitted inside the building.

We ask that you follow the social distancing signage that is located throughout the library.

A staff member will be present at the front door when you enter.

You will be given a card with a number and the time you enter.

A 1 hour time limit per person per day will be given to patrons.


All library/computer services must be completed in the one hour time limit.

If you are checking out books you need to do that prior to getting on the computer.

All returned books must be put in the outside book drop in front of the library.

Curbside pickup will still be available if you would like to use it.

All computers will be sanitized after each session, book carts will be available to put browsed books on for sanitizing. Door handles and frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned regularly.

Starting this month, the Tennessee Department of Revenue is now sending postcards to motor vehicle registrants to remind them of upcoming renewal dates. How do you renew your registration?

The postcards will replace traditional letters and will reduce state mailing expenses by an estimated \$500,000. Other states, including neighboring Kentucky, North Carolina, and Virginia-just to name three, also send postcard notices for registration renewals.

"This is a more efficient, effective way to remind citizens" about their upcoming registration renewals," Commissioner David Gerregano said. "It's also a good way for the state to save money without sacrificing any services." The department partners with the state's 95 county clerks to administer vehicle title and registration in the state. You can find more information about renewals on the department's website at www.tn.gov/revenue/renewals.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the department encourages motorists to renew their registration online at www.andersoncountyclerk.com.

"We are excited to partner with Department of Revenue to help get the word out about this new postcard registration reminder," Jeff Cole Anderson County Clerk said.



Please note that we will be following all the recommendations from the CDC pertaining to COVID-19 for the cleanup. If you are participating in the cleanup with family and/or friends, you will be transported and work with that group. If you are not with a group, we will also be limiting the number of people on boats for transportation to allow for social distancing. Also, a mask will be required when on the boat and when social distancing is not possible. As long as you are appropriately distanced from other participants you will not be required to wear a mask when working on the lake banks.

Volunteers will be cleaning up the lake shore near the launch point and on nearby islands. Boat transportation will be provided but if you a have boat, you are welcome to bring it. You are also encouraged to bring a life jacket if you have one.

Bags will be provided by the Tennessee Valley Authority at all of the locations. Participants are encouraged to bring gloves and wear tennis shoes, boots or other shoes with tread. The lake banks will be muddy so please wear appropriate footwear. Each participant will receive a free T-shirt.
